INSPECTIONS

Roe Green

The Safety Officer continues to undertake monthly inspections of Roe Green play equipment and sports fields, the latest of which was conducted on 5th January 2019. The inspections included a drive/walk through the Village to cover general observations of any PC assets or Village amenities that may require attention or represent a hazard.

The status on the 2 items requiring maintenance / further investigation is as follows:-

- Soccer Goal Posts: Continued deterioration and rusting noted.

Action: The Chair of the Sports Club requested that that these are retained for informal village use and he agreed to organise re-painting in accordance with the RoSPA inspection report.

*Status: **Re-painting not yet done – Safety Officer to follow up with Sports Club.***

- Surfacing beneath play equipment: The honeycomb rubber safety surfacing has sunk into the ground.

*Action: The SO has raised a query with the supplier for their recommended action; supplier has requested additional information on its condition. **Safety Officer to provide this.***

The grass on the cricket outfield has recently been driven over by car(s) with slight damage to the grass. Anyone observing this activity is encouraged to note date time and vehicle particulars.

The discarded wooden pallet and broken chairs behind the cricket pavilion constitute a potential fire hazard and should be disposed of. **Safety Officer to follow up with Sports Club.**

11 items of litter collected from Roe Green, litter bin was 1/3 full.

Pair of Tortoise shell sun glasses found on ground by swings, if yours you will now find them in the Roe Green phone box.
