## Safety Report

### INSPECTIONS

#### Roe Green

The Safety Officer continues to undertake monthly inspections of Roe Green play equipment and sports fields, the latest of which was conducted on 5<sup>th</sup> September. The inspections include a drive/walk through the Village to cover general observations of any PC assets or Village amenities that may require attention or represent a hazard.

No safety issues were noted in the above internal inspection with any of the play or sports equipment on Roe Green, Combustible materials (wooden pallets and broken plastic chairs) remain stored behind the cricket pavilion that should be either removed or stored in the locked shed.

The grass on all Roe Green pitches, and Church Green has been recently mown by our village volunteers.

Roads & verges – Local roads and lanes have been very busy with heavy farm tractors, trailers, harvesting and baling machinery in local months and the number of black tyre skid marks is evidence of a number of emergency stops that have occurred. There is still a significant amount of farm traffic using our lanes this month and with hedges still in full leaf obstructing the views around corners all road users are encouraged to reduce their speed and be extra vigilant.

Bus shelter – Bus shelter roof and bench maintenance tasks remain outstanding, but there is an expectation that this might get done this month!
