

Minutes of Sandon Parish Council Meeting
Thursday 13th August 2020 at 5pm
Remotely via Zoom

Present: Cllr P Bolton, Cllr F Cannon, Cllr K Chamberlain, Cllr B Morris, Cllr J de Uphaugh (Chair)
In attendance: Mrs C Scott Responsible Financial Officer, Mrs H Stubbings, Clerk, and four members of the public.

- 20.45 Welcome.
The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.
Apologies for absence – Cllr B Wordley
- 20.46 Requests for dispensation for disclosable pecuniary interest on items on the agenda – Localism Act 2011 s33 dispensations as standing.
- 20.47 To discuss the land at Mill End farm (Millbury).
Due to the timing of staff vacations within the planning department at NHDC this matter has already been determined and REFUSED on technical matters.
The first application is going to appeal.
Mr & Mrs N Lyness of Mill End informed the meeting that they had applied for ownership of the verge from HCC under adverse possession rights.
- 20.48 The Two Brewers
This application is for Listed Building consent on the two-storey extension. There have been no objections from neighbours. The Parish Council had no objection to this request - **resolved**.
- 20.49 3 Roe Green Cottages
This is a full household application for an extension and a separate building in the garden. The question as to the use of the land for the garden building had been raised; was the land garden or agricultural land?
The Parish Council had no objection to this household application - **resolved**.
- 20.50 The Carriers
This is a re-submitted application with little difference from the previous application. The access has been modified but in principal is still the same as before.
It was agreed to object to this planning application on the grounds as previously set out. – **Resolved**
- 20.51 To discuss matters relating to Covid-19 including sports on Roe Green.
Cllr Bolton was concerned and disappointed about the recent use of the sports field and the lack of care regarding covid protection and compliance. Some behaviour and actions were felt to be dangerous and there had been complaints from residents, some elderly and those needing to 'shield'.
The Parish Council had been provided with appropriate risk assessments and information from both the football and cricket club. Including Covid-19 guidelines, ECB return to cricket plan and Umpire Advice. It was agreed that these documents covered the players, but did not include the risk to spectators. The PC were sympathetic to Pauls comments.
Cllr Bolton had asked to see a copy of the Sports Club insurance, which will be provided.
Cllr Bolton as the representative from Roe Green offered to monitor the situation.
