3 SPC Officers Salaries:

2020-21 NALC pay scale has not been reviewed yet and so we will look at this in the next meeting.

4 Free Reserves: £2917.63

5 Actual spend vs Budget:

Year to date spend is within budget, although the ROSPA inspection was £11.40 more than last year.

6 Section 137 Local Grants:

The 2021/22 PC budget includes the sum of £1,500 (funds to come from PC reserves) for section 137 payments to local clubs and organisations. The current Department of Local Communities & Local Government Section 137 expenditure limit is £8.41 per local elector in the parish, hence with Sandon having 405 registered electors this equates to £ 3,406.05 as the maximum total amount that can be awarded for 2021/22 year. Last year a total of £1,500 was awarded as follows: PCC £400; FOSS £500, Gardeners C £50; Cygnets £75; Herts Air Ambulance £175, Sandon Strollers. The Council should agree a strategy for this year's 137 Local Grants and decide to which, if any, organisations a letter should be sent inviting applications for grants.

1. <u>Bank Mandate changes:</u> The requested changes for the removal of retired councillor F Cannon and the addition of Cllr B Morris is being implemented.
