3 SPC Officers Salaries:

4 Actual spend vs Budget:

Year to date spend is within budget.

5 Section 137 Local Grants:

The 2022/23 PC budget includes the sum of £1,500 (funds to come from PC reserves) for section 137 payments to local clubs and organisations. The current Department of Local Communities & Local Government Section 137 expenditure limit is £8.82 per local elector in the parish, hence with Sandon having 400 registered electors this equates to £ 3,528.00 as the maximum total amount that can be awarded for 2022/23 year. Last year a total of £1,200 was awarded as follows: PCC £400; FOSS £500, Gardeners C £50; Cygnets £75; Herts Air Ambulance £225. The Council should agree a strategy for this year's 137 Local Grants and decide to which, if any, organisations a letter should be sent inviting applications for grants.
