	Highways - Helen has been successful - Gannock Green to Mill End work done. Speed sign at Mill End now in place. Fly tipping was cleared up within the hour. Very impressive.

Rail opposite the school - needs replacing - Helen has been in correspondence with the Council who deny responsibility, to be pursued with Council.

Rails by the pond will be looked at by County Council engineers.

#### Access

Mark Faure Walker has created new permissive rights of way - in principle they are good - one of them is on the corner so is a little dangerous. Existing ones are going to remain for the time being.

Footpath - complaint about quality of surfacing - being addressed with the contractor.

Drovers Path - The new development at Carriers raises concern about the existing adjacent small path that might be used for access by vehicles. It is next to a water way - no known owner. It appears to be a public right of way that has been missed from definitive map and there is an extant DMMO application of more than 2 years ago which will be confirmatory in effect and will not be for vehicular. The fragile nature of the path has been recognised by NHDC planners in relation to another application.

J de U to write a Chair to Chair letter to be sent to North Herts District County Council (Planning) cc County (rights of way) expressing concern about the inconsistent approach both in permitting development outside village envelope where it had been previously refused on the facts and about the need for the council to be aware of this path.
