- 2. 2023/24 Budget & Precept: The approved 2023/24 Budget for Sandon Parish Council is £12835.93 of which £8,750 will come from the NHDC as precept and £3513.44 from Sandon Parish Council's reserves. The RFO will send the Parish Council's precept request for 2023/24 to NHDC together with supporting documents. This precept will (after the contribution of the CTRS grant of £374.67) show as a Parish Council element on local council tax bills as £36.10 for Band D properties, a 5% increase from last year.
- 3. Applications for Grants from Village organisations (Section 137 Expenditure) Carried from November:

Note – The 2022/23 budget includes £1,500 to fund these grants. The current Department of Local Communities & Local Government Section 137(4)(a) expenditure limit is £8.82 per local elector; with 414 electors this equates to £3,651.48 as the maximum permissible for Sandon this year.
